CKBD Two-Part Exam & Testing Deadlines

The four (4) hour Fundamental Exam consists of 200 true/false, multiple choice, and scenario based questions derived from the **NKBA's 4th Edition K&B Panning Guidelines**.

The Portfolio Evaluation consists of the designers own projects and will include one kitchen and one bath project. Drawings must be completed to NKBA Graphic Standards and meet all the criteria before submitting.

The Fundamental Exam to be completed during the Spring (March) and Fall (September) periods. The Portfolio Evaluation to be submitted in the Spring (May) or in the Fall (November). Neither to be completed in any special order, participants discretion.

CKBD Application Checklist
